**FOR ACTION**1. **BILL 64 (2009) – BICYCLES ON ROADWAYS.**

Improve the safety of bicyclists on a roadway by: 1) requiring that motor vehicles maintain a minimum distance from a bicyclist when passing a bicyclist on a roadway, and 2) prohibiting vehicle occupants from throwing any object or substance at a bicyclist. (Bill 64 passed first reading on 8/26/09)

**PROPOSED CD1 TO BILL 64 (2009)** – The CD1 requires that the bicyclist be in compliance with applicable state and city traffic codes. (OCS/082709/08:16/CT)

2. **BILL 59 (2009) – CITY TRANSIT CODE OF CONDUCT.**

Regulate activities on City transit properties, including public transit vehicles and transit facilities. (Bill 59 passed first reading on 8/26/09)
