Hawai'i Bicycling League (HBL)

Hawai'i Bicycling League is a 48-year old 501(c)(3) educational non-profit organization with a mission to enable more people to ride bicycles for health, recreation, and transportation through work in advocacy, education, and events. HBL's BikeEd Hawai'i Program reaches 8,000 fourth grade public school students on O'ahu per year to become safe and responsible bicycle riders. Since 1989, BikeEd Hawai'i has taught bicycle safety to over 100,000 fourth graders.

The HBL BikeEd Instructor is responsible for in-person instruction of our BikeEd Hawai'i Program. This role is crucial to the implementation of HBL's BikeEd Hawai'i program which targets 4th graders in the school system to become safe and responsible bicycle riders. The BikeEd Hawai'i team contributes to the mission of HBL and bicycle education in the broader Hawai'i community. The BikeEd Hawai'i Program consists of two teams, with two primary instructors and a part-time instructor (for additional help on on-the-bike training days) on each team.

Work Schedule: Monday - Friday (and some weekend work), from 7:30am to 4:30pm. Approx. 30/hours per week. This position is being offered for the 2023-2024 School Year beginning August 1, 2023 and ending May 31, 2024, with the possibility for extension. This program is funded through a grant from the City & County of Honolulu. Compensation starts at \$18/hour, with health insurance coverage after 30 days of full-time employment.

HBL BikeEd Instructor Qualities:

1. Organizational and leadership skills:
Is motivated with strong organizational skills and attention to detail. Supervisory experience preferred. Must be a good communicator, detail oriented, task focused, and have good time management skills. Must wear a helmet while bicycling, work well within a team environment, and be able to provide guidance and direction from the BikeEd Manager. Ability to adapt easily to a fast-paced environment.
2. Bicycle skills, prior experience teaching and working with children:
Must have experience and understanding of basic bicycling skills (safe and proper ways to operate a bicycle and basic bicycle maintenance). Must have experience and confidence in providing instruction to others with an emphasis on instructing children. Must have a passion for teaching youth.
3. Must possess a valid state driver's license with a clean record to operate the BikeEd truck.

HBL BikeEd Instructor Job Duties & Responsibilities:

- Work closely with the BikeEd Manager to participate in a 2-3-person instructional team.
- Instruct students in the complete on-bike and on-road BikeEd Program curriculum Monday-Friday on school days
- Complete weekly school reports on the school spreadsheet to record number of students taught, number of beginners, number of students that ride their bike to school, % total from pre-test and number of bike racks located at the school.
- Oversee completion of basic bike repairs on a weekly basis.
- Safeguard all BikeEd equipment and materials and take inventory on a consistent basis.
- Communicate clearly with team members and BikeEd Manager about BikeEd and matters affecting it.
- Manage inventory of BikeEd helmets, t-shirts, keiki memberships, and other merchandise to support the BikeEd program and communicate with BikeEd Manager to reorder supplies.
- Keep the BE storage shelves cleaned, organized.
- Work closely with BikeEd Manager to complete any incident reports for injury or property damage.

- Arrange for photographs and video of students and teachers to be taken and posted to HBL website to encourage students and parents to bicycle more and participate in other HBL activities.
- Promote events such as Aloha Fun Ride to BikeEd participants and their parents with the assistance of the Events Director.
- Participate in meetings with the BikeEd Manager and entire BikeEd Hawai'i Program staff as needed.
- Assist in scheduling quarterly truck maintenance (oil change and tire rotations) during school breaks.
- Investigate ways to increase bicycling by students and parents beyond BikeEd week at each school.
- Attend HBL board meetings and participate in HBL functions when requested and when time allows.
- Other duties as assigned.
